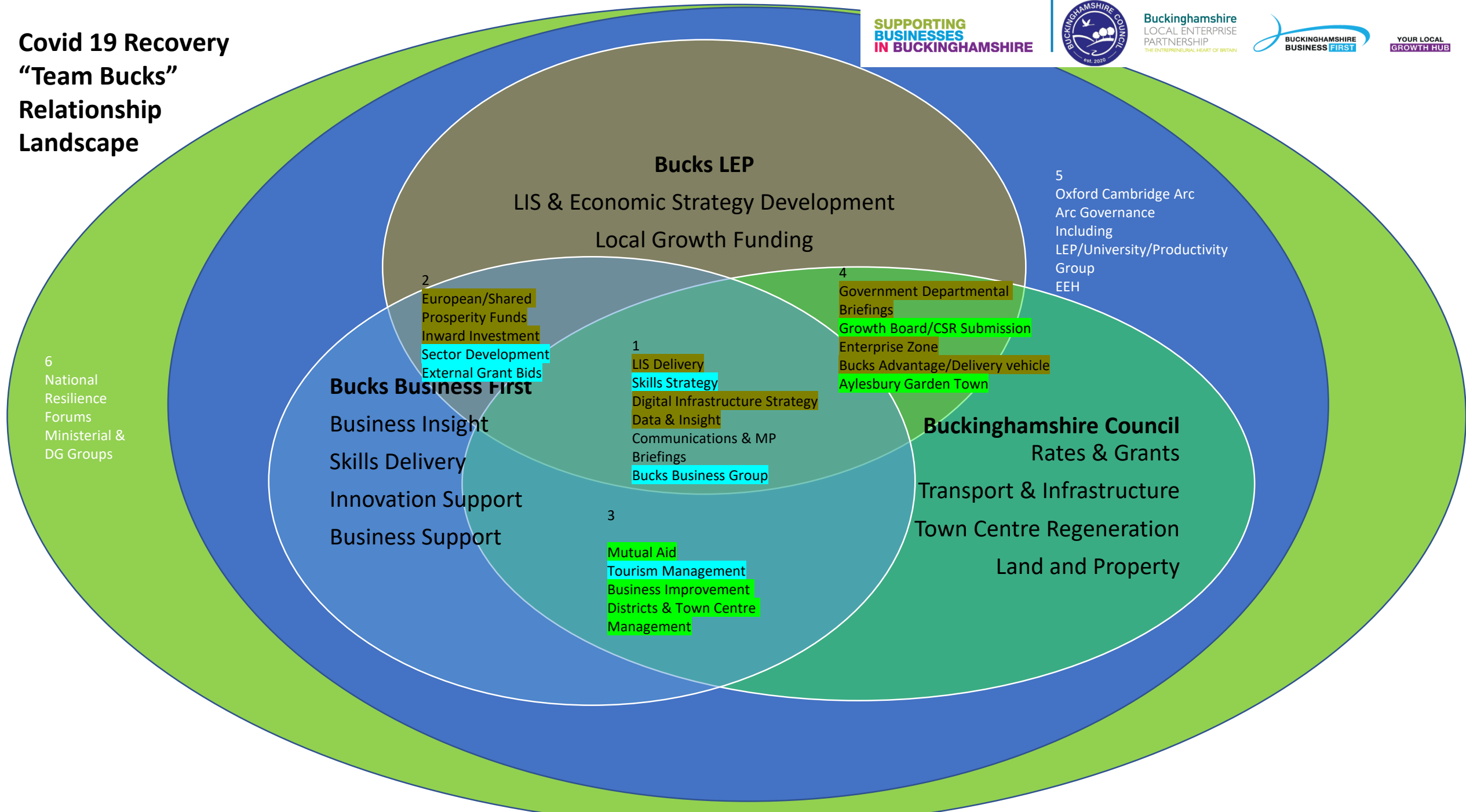

Key to Interfaces

1 Overlap between all 3 partners

Local Industrial Strategy Delivery (LEP Managed) All partners will have the responsibility for delivering on joint strategy objectives.

Skills Strategy (BBF managed) – co-ordinated through Skills Advisory Panel, reporting to LEP Board

Digital Infrastructure Strategy (LEP managed) – to be reported to LEP Board as complementary to Local Industrial Strategy

Data & Insight (LEP co-ordinated) includes weekly data insight and longer term data trends - to be made available as open source data observatory.

Communications & MP Briefings – no current lead, jointly managed approach – needs strong link to communications cell

Bucks Business Group (BBF managed) – providing insight for/to business organisations active in Buckinghamshire

2 LEP/BBF Overlap

European/Shared Prosperity Funds (LEP co-ordinated) currently managed through ESIF Committee, BBF active in programme delivery.

Inward Investment (LEP managed) linking with DIT to support the promotion of inward investment opportunities, currently under resourced – integral to Arc investment programme.

Sector Development (BBF/LEP Joint Approach) Supporting business growth and collaboration across target sectors from the Local Industrial Strategy

External Grant Bids (BBF managed) For partnership development related to external funding applications, resources limited.

3 Buckinghamshire Council / BBF Overlap

Voluntary Sector Mutual Aid (Council managed) Linking with BBF to provide access to business community

Tourism Management (BBF Managed) Visit Buckinghamshire Destination Management Organisation

Business Improvement Districts & Town Centre Management (Council Managed) different operational activities in different geographies, supported by BBF to access and co-ordinate business sector involvement.

4 LEP / Buckinghamshire Council Overlap

Government Departmental Briefings (LEP managed) Weekly links with Cities and Local Growth Unit (HMCLG/BEIS) comprehensive cross departmental engagement through Growth Board.

Growth Board/CSR Submission (Council managed) developing strategy for spatial growth, overseeing infrastructure planning and co-ordinating overall submission for Comprehensive Spending Review

Buckinghamshire Advantage/Delivery Vehicle (LEP Company) Opportunity for this vehicle to be used for the acquisition and development of strategic development sites.

Enterprise Zone (LEP managed) advancing development of 3 EZ sites, accountable body and rates investment overseen by BC

Aylesbury Garden Town (Council managed) Opportunity for innovation testbed process to be further integrated into Garden Town Programme
